

## **PRIVACY POLICY**

WebTurbo Services established in Mexico (we, us or the Company) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy together with any document related to the sale of our Tokens (CT) and any other document to which reference is made, establishes the basis on which the personal data that we collect from you or that you provide us will be processed by us.

Carefully read the following to understand our opinions and practices regarding your personal information and how we will treat them.

By visiting <https://webturbo.org> and all its affiliates (Website in general, and in specific <https://webturbo.org/ico>), you accept all the terms, privacy and services, internal regulations and practices described in this policy.

### **INFORMATION WE COLLECT FROM YOU**

We will collect and process the following information about you:

#### **1. Information that you provide.**

This includes any personal information you provide us by completing forms on the website or by contacting us by phone, email or otherwise.

It also includes information you provide when you register to use our website, subscribe to our service, participate in discussion panels or other social media features on our site, participate in a competition, promotion or survey, contribute to our sale of tokens. (as defined in terms of our sale of tokens) and when you report a problem with our site.

The information you provide may include your name, address, email address and phone number, date of birth, financial information, personal description and photograph, cryptocurrency addresses and any other personal information that is provided to us.

#### **2. Information we collect about you.** With respect to each of your visits to our site, we will automatically collect the following information:

Technical information, including the Internet Protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, your login information (if applicable), browser type and version, time zone settings, browser add-on types and versions, operating system and platform information about your visit, including the uniform resource locators (URL), clickstream to, from and to our site (including date and time), information that you saw or searched, page response times, errors download, duration of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks and mouseover), methods used to navigate off the page and any information about you related to communicate with our customer service team (for example, phone number).

Information we receive from other sources. This is information we receive about you from the public domain, third parties or other websites that we operate or the other services we provide. The third parties we work with include: business partners, technical subcontractors, payment and delivery services, advertising networks, analytics providers, search information providers, and credit reference agencies.

## **COOKIES**

To make this site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big websites do this too.

### **WHAT ARE COOKIES?**

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

### **HOW DO WE USE COOKIES?**

1. Security – we use cookies to enable and support our security features, and to help us detect malicious activity.
2. Preferences, features, and services – cookies can tell us which language you prefer and what your communications preferences are.
3. Performance, analytics and research – cookies help us learn how well our site performs in different locations. We also use cookies to understand, improve, and research products, features, and services, including when you access our website from other applications, or devices such as your work computer or your mobile device.

### **HOW TO CONTROL COOKIES**

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see [aboutcookies.org](http://aboutcookies.org). You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.

### **USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION**

We use the information we have about you in the following ways:

1. Information you give us.

We will use this information:

- a. To carry out our obligations derived from any contract between us and to provide you with the information, products and services you request.
- b. To notify you about changes to our service.
- c. To ensure that the content of our site is presented in the most effective way for you and your computer.

2. Information we collect about you.

We will use this information:

- a. To administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research purposes, statistics and surveys.

- b. To improve our site, to ensure that content is presented in the most effective way for you and your computer;
  - c. To allow you to participate in interactive functions of our service, when you choose to do so.
  - d. As part of our efforts to keep our site safe and secure.
3. Information we receive from other sources.

We will combine this information with the information you give us and the information we collect about you and (depending on the types of information we receive) will be used as described above.

### **DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION**

You agree that we have the right to share your personal information with:

1. Any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries.
2. Selected third parties, including:
  - a. Business partners, suppliers and subcontractors for the execution of any contract that we enter with them or with you.
  - b. Analytics and search engine providers that help us improve and optimize our site.
  - c. Fraud and crime prevention agencies with the purpose of evaluating the risk of crime, fraud and money laundering, and this is a condition for us to enter into a contract with you.

We will disclose your personal information to third parties:

1. As required by law.
2. In case we sell or buy any business or asset, in which case we will disclose your personal information to the possible seller or buyer of said business or assets.
3. If the Company, or the majority of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case the personal data it holds about its customers will be one of the assets transferred.
4. If we have a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or to enforce or apply Token Terms and Conditions of Sale and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property or safety of the Company, our customers or others. This includes the exchange of information with other companies and organizations with the aim of protecting against fraud, money laundering in the prevention and reduction of credit risk.
5. To ensure that we can successfully search our Sale of tokens and comply with our legal and contractual obligations with you related to the sale of tokens.
6. To avoid crime, money laundering and the risk of fraud.
7. To ensure that we have relevant information about the people who wish to contribute to our sale of tokens.

8. To ensure that the underlying network that will be developed by virtue of the Token Sale and / or in which the Tokens are intended to be usable, has sufficient and relevant information to support you and your use of the Tokens.

9. In order to provide relevant information to regulators, government agencies and banks that may request information about the Sale of Tokens.

#### **WHERE WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA**

All the information you provide us is stored on our secure servers.

The data we collect from you can be transferred and stored in a destination outside the Mexican Economic Space (EEM). It can be processed by personnel who operate outside the EEM who work for us or for one of our suppliers. This includes personnel dedicated, among other things, to the fulfillment of your order, to the processing of your payment details and to the provision of support services.

By submitting your personal data, you accept this transfer, storage or processing. We will take all measures reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this policy.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information through the Internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we can not guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.
